Robert Beasley acknowledged this Deed with the Livery of Seizin entered to be his act and Deed & thereupon the same was admitted to record then Mary wife of the said Robert (she being first privately examined) relinquished her right of Dower in the Land by this Deed conveyed which was also admitted to record.
