Twenty three and a half acres of land for which I have Stephen Butkers Bond bounded by the  
Bond on the upper side by Daniel Jones line and the lower side by Matthew Dages in the  
same manner to him and his Heirs for ever Secondly I give and bequeath unto my Sister  
Matthew Woodson one Silver Spoon Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my Cuzon Judith Woodson  
Thirty Shillings to be paid her in aforesay forthly and Lastly I give and bequeath all the residue of my  
Laste roall and personall unto my loving father Joseph Woodson and him I make and  
Institute my hole and sole Executor the word and a half Enterlind before asind.
