This Indenture made this 24th Day of December one Thousand Seven Hundred and twenty Eight Between Benjamin Hopkins of the County of Henrico of the one part and Thomas Oliver of the aforesaid County of the other part Witness that the said Benjamin Hopkins for the Valuable Consideration of the sum of Eleven Pounds Current money to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Oliver the Receipt Whereof he doth acknowledge and himself fully satisfied and thereof doth acquit the said Thomas Oliver having granted alledged Bargained sold恩承 and confirmed and by these presents do fully clearly and absolutely assign grant alien Bargain Enfeof and Confirm unto his said Thomas Oliver one certain Tract of Land called Shury Hill lying on the South side of Clintons joining upon Major John Rollings Tract and Ligan in the County aforesaid containing one hundred acres to the same more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid Land with all privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Thomas Oliver his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Hopkins for his heirs Executors or Administrators so covenant with the said Thomas Oliver his said Land principles will forever warrant and defend against any claim and title that hereafter may be laid to the aforesaid premises by him the said Benjamin Hopkins or his heirs or any other claiming under us to fulfill all the aforesaid Covenants and agreements The said Benjamin Hopkins doth bind himself his heirs Executors adm^rs and assigns In Witness whereof the said Benjamin Hopkins hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written.
