Constitute ordain & appoint this my last will and Testament in all manner of form following Impinge I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Pleasants the Land & plantation with on Richd. Harps now lives known by the name of Dickmation beginning at the mouth of the Doye Swamp then to the S. Swamp & a large branch of the S. Swamp parting that plantation & that with Richd. Harps wife now is sit. thence up the S. branch untill it meet Obadiah Smiths line thence along the said line to the head including in the S. bounds the one hundred acres land with was formerly Tho: Robinsons his whole tract containing by estimation three hundred acres to the same more or less with S. Land & plantation I give to him the S. Joseph & his heirs for ever I give & bequeath to my son John Pleasants the Land & plantation whereon W^m Harris formerly lived above the Doye Swamp also all my Land betwixt the horse Swamp from the great branch bounding my son Josephs up the the S. Swamp and Obadiah Smiths line to the head of my Land including the plantation whereon Richard Harps wife now lives both with plantation & Land Contains by estimation one hundred and fifty acres with I give to the S. John and his heirs for ever I give to my son Richd. Pleasants all my Land adjoining to the upper side of Suffoles branch being by estimation three hundred acres now with I give to W^m Nuttall & his heirs for ever I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Pleasants that plantation or Parcel of Land by me purchased of John Watson Lyngon or near a branch of Cuckahes on the Head of a branch called Long Hungrey by estimation two hundred acres with I give to him the S.  be paid with out the Charge of Law but the Creditors proving their Debts before two Justices of the peace & my
 will is that my Children abide with their mother During her widow hood untill there may be seen Lawfull Cause to
 Choose a garden other wise to remain with their mother till they arrive to Lawfull years Item & Lastly I make
 ordain and Constitute my loving wife Martha Pleasants my whole & sole Execatrix of this my last will and
 Testament hereby revoking & annulling all former wills and Testaments of any kind or nature what so ever my will
 ther is that my wife undertake not to sell her selfe in any business of any moment without the Consent or advice
 my to wit the saying Colonel Standolph whom I beg the favour of to advise her In witness that this is my last will
