This Indenture made the 5th Day of October 1728 by and between Nicholas Cox of James's parish of Henrico of the one part and John Martin of the parish and County aforesaid of the other part to witte both that the said Nicholas Cox for an in consideration of the sum of five hundred pounds of most current Tobacco to him in hand already paid and satisfied hath given granted and by these presents doth absolutely alien Enfeoff and grant unto the said John Martin his heirs or assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing four hundred Acres more or less patent granted laying and being in the County aforesaid and on the North side James River on a Branch of Carters Creek and bounded as follows to witte beginning at a corner White Oak on Carters Line Thence North thirty two Degrees East one hundred and sixty Chain to a corner to these points thence East thirty five Degrees South thirty eight Chain to a corner white Oak on a Branch of Carters Creek Thence South thirty two Degrees East one hundred thirty and one Chain to a corner white Oak on Carters Line Thence West twenty Degrees North thirty four Chain to a corner white Oak Thence South twenty Degrees West thirty five Chain to a corner white Oak Thence East thirty five Degrees North sixty five Chain thence North to the place began at -
to witte all manner and all singular the members Rights Appurtenances whatsoever together with all and every Good Willing and Evidence to the said tract or parcel of Land or to any part or parcel thereof in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and all singular other the premises unto the said Martin his heirs and assigns forever and that in as firm ample manner to all intents and purposes as an Estate in fee simple absolute to be hold or enjoyed and such an Estate in and for the premises the said Nicholas Cox binds and obliges himself his heirs and assigns by this deed to warrant and for ever defend to be good and valid to the said John Martin his heirs and assigns for ever against any or all manner of persons claiming under any pretence right or title whatsoever and also that the said Nicholas Cox his heirs and assigns shall and will make and execute other deeds for the better allowing and complying the premises by the true meaning of this deed unto the said John Martin his heirs and assigns forever as by him them or their counsel shall be required to the punctual performance true keeping fulfilling of all and singular the premises aforesaid
