Twenty two and in the ^{ninth} year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George of Great Britain and Ireland
King &c. Whereas I Mathew Branch Son^t of the County of Hunter being in perfect and sound
memory thanks be god although not in perfect health do hereby ordain constitute and appoint this my
Last will & Testament as in manner following Imprimis I resign up my soul to Almighty god And
further believing in the merits of Jesus Christ my redeemer and my body to be buried in ground by
and at the direction of my Executrix hereafter named as to my worldly effects what it hath pleased
god to bestow upon me after my debts and funeral charges are paid I give and bequeath as followeth
Item I give and bequeath to my son Mathew Branch my plantation I now dwell on to him and his heirs
forever only I give my loving wife the lower half with the dwelling house I now live in during her
natural life and the half of the out houses Likewise I give to my son Mathew my land which
lies on the head of my brother Thomas branch & Joyns to my brother James commonly called
Barbades I also give him a piece of land Joyning to John Blackmans land which he bought
of Mr. John Cullitt and do to my son Mathew my land both here and at Barbades to have &
providing on my son Mathew's land both here and at Barbades to have timber and stone
for building and keeping in repair his plantation I now live on Item I give my son John
Branch the whole part of the land taken up between my brother James and myself to him the
John Branch and his heirs for ever Item I give unto my son Oliver and Daniel Branch
my land that I bought of Mr. John Cullitt and it is my will that that the said land be equal-
ly divided and that my son Oliver should have that part next to p[re]wits and that Daniel

Shall have the other part next to his ready Creek and in case that either his s^t. Olives or Daniel should
Dye in their non age one before the other that then the surviving person shall possess and Enjoy the
whole tract of Land to him and his Heirs for Ever and allos if both Shall Live to Enjoy their Equall
part of the Land itt Shall be to them and their Heirs for Ever Item I give my Son Thomas Branch
one hundred and fifty acres of Land which I took up with Cap. Jefferson. Thomas Harris,
and Thomas Turpin to him and his Heirs for Ever Item Likewise give my Son Olives a
Grey Colt two years old with a white face likewise I give my Sonn Thomas a blacke Colt a year old
with wall Eyes; and white blazys in his face to them and their Exe^t heirs or assigns Item I give my
Daughter pieble Branch a bay Mare dark coulerd to her and her heirs for Ever Item I give my
Daughter Elizabeth Branch a bay mare commonly call^d pitch to her and her heirs for Ever
Item all the rest of my Estate I leave with my wife to be Disposed of among my Children as she
pleases or thinks fitt and I Doe hereby make my loving wife whole and sole Executrix of this
my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and Seal this day
and Date above mentioned.
