 Between Robert Gopeck of this County of Henrico and parish of Potts of the one part and David Evans of the same County and parish
 of the other part witnesseth that he said Robert Gopeck for and in consideration of the sum of seven pounds current Money
 to him in hand paid by the said David Evans his Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and knoweth doth require and
 discharge the said David Evans his heirs Executors & Executrixes bold alienated his self and his wife and doth by this
 presents absolutely Bargain sell alienate his self and his wife unto the said Robert Gopeck his heirs and executors forever One certain
 tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred Acres more or less situated lying and being in this County of Henrico and parish
 of Potts lying on the uplands of Harey Brook on Appomattox River being out of land of Thomas Hampson which said tract of land
 was given to the said Robert Gopeck by his self Hilland Cottenant of Corp Archs Potts his self the fourteenth Day of October one thousand
 Seven hundred and Twenty two to have and to hold the said tract of one hundred Acres of land with all houses out
 houses orchards & plantations belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said David Evans his heirs and executors forever to him
