In the name of GOD Amen: I Rebecca Elmore of y^e County of Henrico being in health of mind and Memory do Dispose of my worldly Estate as followeth. I give unto my son Thomas Elmore one half of my Tract of Land whereon I now live Containing two hundred and Seventy five Acres to him and his Heirs forever. I give unto my Daughter Elisabeth Elmore the other half of my Land including the plantation whereon I now live to her and the Heirs of her Body Lawfully begotten and if she dy without such heir then to my grandson John Elmore son of Peter Elmore to him and his Lawfull heirs forever. I give unto my Daughter Elisabeth Elmore my Negroe Girl named Judy she & her Increase to her and the Heirs of her body Lawfully begotten and if she dy without such Heir to be Equally divided with the rest of my Estate. I give unto my Granddaughter Lucy Elmore Daughter of William Elmore one two year Old heiffer,

All the remaining part of my Estate both Real & personal I give to be
Equally Divided between my five Children and my son Peter Elmore on
phans to Com in for one sixt part with my five Children. (Viz)
William Elmore, Thomas Elmore Elisabeth Elmore Beththiah Mitchel
and Mary Mitchel to them and there Heirs for ever my will & my will
and desire that my Estate be not Appraised. I do Constitute and appoint
my son William Elmore Executor of this my last will and Testament
this 19 day of May 1744.

Alex^r. Trent heirs and Assigns for ever one Lot containing half
an Acre in a certain Town called New Glasgow lately Laid off
in the County of Henrico which Lot is Numbered thirty eight in
the plan of the said Town to have and to hold the said Lot together with
all the priviledges and Advantages thereunto belonging to the said
Alexander Trent heirs and Assigns for ever and the said Alex^r. Spiers
