And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give Devise and Dispose of the same in following manner and form I give my Land to my Brother Henry Sharpe and if he should die without Issue then I do give it to my Sister Elizabeth Frogmorton's Son Robert Frogmorton I give my horse to my Sister Mary Sharpe and all the rest of my Estate I give to my Exec^{rs}. And of this my last will and Testament I make my brother Henry Sharpe my sole Exec^{or}. witness my hand and Seals this 14th Day of April: 1726.

Discretion of my Exec^{rs} hereafter named. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Hannah Throat one Shilling Sterling. Item I give & bequeath to my Loving wife Martha Stanly & to her heirs for ever one feather bed & furniture which she brought to me (viz.) one blue yarn Sett with three Eight quarter blankets five Sheets a towel & linge. also one Steer at five years old two at two years old and two cows. also one grey Horse branded with a pair of fire tongues Likewise six breeding Sows Eight barrows & three Shoats one Iron pot of about three Gallons one Choff and one Couth four pewter Dishes four plates &c. one Bason cup & Salt Sellar of pewter one Iron pottle & one Wiciron &c.
