This Indenture made and concluded this 5th day of May in the year of Our Lord one thousand seven
 hundred and twenty nine between Thomas Pleasants of the County of Henrico of the one part and Thomas
 Watkins of the same County of the other part witnesseth that the aforesaid Thomas Pleasants for the value
 consideration of fifteen hundred pounds of Tobacco to him in hand paid by the aforesaid Thomas Watkins he
 the undersigned and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Thomas Pleasants doth here
 acknowledge and thereof and from every part and parcel doth fully clearly and absolutely acquit and
 discharge him the said Thomas Watkins his heirs and adm^r and hath by these presents bargained
 sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and in and by these presents doth fully clearly and absolutely bargain sell
 alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas Watkins his heirs and assigns for ever one urban tract or parcel
 of Land situate lying and being in the County of Henrico and on the North side of James River containing by Esti
 mation fifty Acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth Viz. on the South by the main Run of the White Oak
 Swamp on the East by the Lands of Edw. Wills which was formerly sold to Giles Carter by John Pleasants as by Deeds for
 the same may appear on the North by the Land of Robert Childers and on the West by that Branch called Rich
 which parted the said Watkins Land from the within bargained and sold premises together with all Out Houses
 Houses Gardens Orchards hedges Ditches and Tenements with all and singular the Appurtenances and appurtenances th
 belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the aforesaid fifty Acres of Land with all and sing
 the
