 hundred and thirty and six Between John Burton of Morris County of the one part and Thomas Burton of  
 other part witnesseth that for the Natural love and affection which I bear unto my son Thomas Burton I give unto my  
 said Son and to his heirs forever one Tract of Land containing by estimation eighty five Acres More or Less as I have  
 laid it off Joining on James Burton on the South side of falling Creek, which lands I give unto Thomas Burton and  
 his heirs forever together with all Houses, Orchards, Woods, Underwoods, Water, and Watercourses therunto Belonging on  
 any way appertaining together with all the Appurtenances therunto belonging unto the above named Thomas  
 Burton and to his heirs forever furthermore I do Warrant and forever defend this land Tract of Land as its laid of  
 against me my heirs Executors, Administrators or Assigns in Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and  
 Seal this fourth Day of March 1736
