In the Name of God amen I Thomas Childers of the parish and County of Henrico being sick ^{and weak} but of perfect mind & memory praised be almighty God, do make and give in this my last Will and Testament, Bequeathing my soul to god who gave it and my Body to be buried a Christian Buryal according to the Directions of my Executor hereafter ^{mentioned} I give and devise unto my son Phelomon Childers one Tract or dividend of Land lying on the West side of my son Thomas Childers and go a straight line from a certain cross path near Amos Litchers to the head of a Spring Branch near the plantation whereon I now dwell, thence down the said branch as far as my said Land doth extend being part of the land on w^{ch} I now dwell unto my said son and his heirs forever. Item I give and devise unto my son James Childers and his heirs forever one tract or Dividend of Land joining to a certain spring branch being the line of my son Phelomon and on the westward side of the Land of my son John Childers on the East side of Thomas Matthews Land being the land and plantation on w^{ch} I now dwell. Item I give and Bequeath unto my loving Wife mary Childers all the remaining part of my Estate after my Lawfull Debts are paid out of the same whom I constitute and appoint the whole and sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have set to my hand and affixed my seal this 15th of November 1734.

This Indenture made this third day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty six Between Martha Good of the parish of Dale and County of Henrico of the one part and John Reed of the same County and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Martha Good for the valuable consideration of Thirty seven pounds current money when in hand paid the Receipt whereof she hath hereby acknowledged and thereof acquit and Discharge the said John Reed his heirs Executors and Assigns hath given granted sold aliened Enfeoffed and confirmed by said John Reed and to his heirs forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred Acres more or less and the said Land is the lower part of a large Tract of Land called and known by the Name of middle Creek and the said Land lately belong to Sam^r Good deceased late husband to the said Martha Good and was ordered to be sold by the last Will and Testament of the said Sam^r Good and bounded as followeth beginning at an Elm standing on the North side of Appomattock river
