Containing by Estimation fifty five acres more or less for which S^r Land Michael Camper had a patent from the last Governor Spotswood him the S^r Michael his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever to have & to hold the S^r Land and all bur^{ns} now thereon to the S^r George Macchbanks and his heirs forever and the S^r George for him sold his heirs Executor Adminis^r shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the above named Daniel Croome immediately after the acknowledgment of the said Land by the S^r Daniel Croome & Elizabeth his wife Relinquishing her right into or of the said Land & of the Sum of forty pounds Current money of Virginia and the said
