At a Court held for Henrico County the first monday in February 1745 William Belcher acknowledged this Deed with the Livery & Seizin Indow'd to Benjamin Dison to be his Act and Deed then Priscilla his wife she being first privately Examined relinquished her right of Dower in the Land by the said Deed Enrolled all which was admitted to Record.
