In the Name of God amen Thomas Knibb of the County of Henrico being of
Perfect mind and memory Blest be God for it do make and order this my Last Will and
Testament in manner and form following. first I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God hoping through the meritorious death and passion of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
to Receive free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and my Body I commit to the Earth to be
Decently Interred at y^e Discretion of my Executrix: hereafter Named and as for what
Worldly Estate it hath Pleased God to blef me with I Dispose of as followeth. —
First I give Give and bequeath to my Daughter Anne Hatcher fifty acres of Land
where she now Liveth be the same more or less as it is bounded and after the Decease of
my said Daughter Anne and her Husband James Hatcher I give the aforesaid fifty
Acres of Land to his Son my grandson Thomas Hatcher to him the said Thomas and to
his heirs for ever the abovesaid Land Bounded as followeth Beginning on the North Side
my Clear Ground at a Corner Black Oak standing in a path going Down to the water as it is
marked out so down James River to Tanners line so up the S^d Tanners line to my
Spring Run thence up the S^d Spring run to a corner pine standing on the brow of a hill
thence to an Elbow Chesnut Tree thence as it marked out to a Corner Black Oak the
Place begun at, Secondly all the Remainder part of my Land Where I now live

Joining on my Son in Law Jamstone Hatcher buildings houses Orchards &c with
all the appurtenances thereunto belonging I give unto my Daughter Obedience Knibb
to her the S. Obedience & to her heirs for ever to be possessed with after the Decease of her Mother
Anne Knibb I also give unto my S. Daughter Obedience one feather bed and the furni-
ture belonging to it. Thirdly I give to my loving wife Anne Knibb one Hundred
Acres of Land lying in Henrico County at Sapony the Station and Land Where W. M.
Cutts now lieth being one half the Tract of Two Hundred Acres taken up w. M. T.
Joseph Wilkinson to her and to her heirs for ever I also give the Other Hundred acres of my
Land at Sapony Joining on Benj. Branch to my Grandson Jamstone Hatcher to him
and to his heirs for ever Fourthly I desire that my wife Anne shall have the use and pri-
vilege of the plantation Where I now live and what Negroes I am now possessed with Dur-
ing her Natural life and after her Decease I give my Negro girl Mary to my Daughter
Obedience Knibb I also give my Negro man Abraham to my Daughter Mary Knibb
and one feather bed and furniture thereunto belonging Lastly all the Remainder of my
personal Estate not already given I give unto my loving wife Anne Knibb and do
make her my full & sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In Witness where-
of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th Day of December 1744.
