tainty of this Transitory life on Earth and y^t all Flesh must yield unto
Death. doe make & ordain this to be my last will & Testament Viz first
I recommend my Soul to God y^t made it & my body to the Earth from whence it
was Taken to be buried in such Christian & decent manner as my Ex^{rs}
hereafter mentioned shall thinke meet & convenient & as to my Temporal
Estate I give & dispose of in manner & form Following Viz first I desire all
my Just debts may be duely Paid & Discharged. Item. I give & devise unto
my Son Peter Webster & his Heirs for ever the Plantation he now lives on
in the County of amelia Including Four Hundred & fifty Acres of Land
one Hundred Acres of which to be taken out of my last Survey of Four
hundred Acres Adjoining on him I also give unto my Said Son Peter
all the Stock of Cattle hogs & all the House hold goods &c. that

he is now a Possessor of. I also give & devise unto my said Son Peter & his
Heirs for ever the one half or Moity the Land now live on In the County of
Henrico on the on the South side of the Old Town Creek being the lower Part
of the said Tract of Land. According to a line marked ~~there~~ & agreed on
by said Son Peter & my Self. I then I give & devise unto my Son Thomas Web-
ster & his Heirs for ever Four hundred & fifty Acres of Land In the County
of Amelia being the Lower Part of my Survey & where John Blanchet
formerly Dwelt. I also give unto my ^(said) Son Thomas all the stock of cattle
& hogs & one Mare & Foal now on the Plantation or belonging to the Plantation
also one Oil Table. I then I give unto & Occupation of the upper half or
moity of the Land & with the Plantation. I now live on lying on the South
side of the Old Town Creek to my loving Wife Prudence during her
Natural Life and after her decease I give & devise the said Land &
Plantation a fores^d to my Son Thomas & his Heirs for ever. I also give un-
to my said Thomas One carbabine one sword a pair of Pistolls & Car-
touch box. one Large Bible & all my Carpenters & Joiners Tools &
Coopers Tools & Shoemakers Tools. & the one half of my Large brass Kettle
I also give unto my said Son Thomas my Negro Man Named
Jemmy I give unto my Son Peter Webster the half of my Large brass
Kettle and one pair Pistolls & Holsters I then I give & devise to my daugh-
ter Rosamond Cousins and her Heirs for ever One Hundred & fifty Acres of
Land in the County of Amelia lying on the South Side of a Gully called &
known by the Name of the deep gully being Part of a Tract of Four Hun-
dred Acres. I then I give & devise unto my Son Peter Webster & the

Heirs of his body Lawfully begotten for Ever One hundred & fifty Acres
of Land in the County of Amelia lying on both sides of the Wolf Branch
being ^(also) Part of the afores^d. Tract of Five Hundred Acres. Item I give & de-
vise unto my Daughter Elizabeth Webster and the Heirs of her body
Lawfully begotten for Ever One hundred Acres of Land in the County
of Henrico on the North side of Old Town Creek to begin at the upper
end of the said Tract of Land Item I give & devise unto my Daughter
Anne Webster and the Heirs of her body Lawfully begotten for ever One
Hundred Acres of Land in the said County of Henrico on the North side
of the old Town Creek adjoining the above Mentioned tract of Land
given to my Daughter Elizabeth Item I give & devise unto my son Tho-
mas Webster & his heirs for Ever all the remaining part of my Land
lying on the North Side of the Old Town Creek Item I give the use
& Occupation of my Negroe man Named Sesar to my Loving Wife
Prudence during her Natural life & after her Decease I give the
said Negroe Sesar to my Grandson John Webster Item I give unto
my afores^d. wife Prudence my riding Horse Item I give unto my daugh-
ter Mary Gibbs a Large Leather Trunch which was her Mothers
Item I give to my Wife Prudence one fourth Part of the remaining part of my
Estate Not already given away. Item I give to my Daughter Rosamond
Cousins one fourth part of my Estate as afores^d. Item I give to my daugh-
ter Elizabeth one fourth Part of my Estate Item I give ^{unto} my Daughter Anne
one fourth Part of my Estate, I desire my Estate may not be Invented nor
