Rodrick Lasley three Negroes, Famine, Joe & Frank to have and his
 heirs forever, and all y^e Rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided between
 them and it is my desire that it shall be don without any apase
 ment and I do hereby apint my two sons Robert & Rodrick
 Lasley to be my hole and sole Executors of this my last will &
 Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand
 and Seale this twenty forth of September Anno. 1727.

 Henrico of the one part and Thomas Bass of the same County

 in Consideration of the sum of Ten pounds Current money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid by the aforesaid Thomas Bass the receipt
