 of my estate if any part of the rent is paid and the charge

and the young man that is to be married to the said daughter of mine
 shall have the said house and the said land and the said house and the said land
 of my said son if any part of the rent is paid and the charge
 of the said house and the said land and the said house and the said land
 and the money to my son Robert the son being 4 pound
 in a year and for ever more it is my will that my son
 Robert should have to John White to have his land and
 to have him to have and to have and to have and to have
 to my son and have Estey, circa 1700, I give and bequeath
 John Estey 5 shillings for the said house and bequeath
 to my two daughters all my wearing clothes & all my tools and
 I give and bequeath to my son William Estey all
 the remainder of my estate and my son William to be
 my full and sole Executor of all my estate
