 wife Ruth Scherer and Samuel Scherer my beloved son Executors of this
 my last Will and Testament, Inprimis, I give and bequeath unto
 my beloved Wife Ruth Scherer my House and lot whereas I now live
 and half my plantation in the County of Hanover and half of one
 tract of Land in Henrico County containing one hundred fifty Acres
 also five Negroes namely Carry, Aaron, Molly, Phibby & John, Phibby
 whose increase to be given to whom she pleases It is my Will & desire
 that after her decease the Land and Tenements devolve to my beloved
 son Samuel Scherer my son also I give and bequeath unto my
