I give and devise unto my daughter Martha Binford the use
of a Negro named Sam Hall till she come to age and one horse and saddle
I give and devise unto my daughter Mary Binford the use
of a Negro named Sam Hall till she come to age and one horse and saddle

Wm. Winford the use of a Negro Girl named Agg till she comes to age
and one bed and furniture to her and her heirs. I give and devise
unto my son Benjamin Winford the use and use of a Negro Boy
named Daniel till he comes to age one horse and saddle one bed and
furniture to him and his heirs. I give and devise unto my son
Thomas Winford the use and use of a Negro Boy named Abraham till
he comes to age one horse and saddle one bed and furniture to him
and his heirs. I give unto my daughter Sarah Winford the
use of a Negro Girl named Sellar one bed and furniture and one
saddle to her and her heirs. I give unto my son Samuel Winford
the use of one Negro Girl named Pleasant and another Negro Child
that is not born both till they come to age one horse and saddle one
bed and furniture to him and his heirs. all the rest and residue
of my Estate I give and devise to my wife as long as she lives, and
then to be equally divided among my children. I appoint James
Ladd, William Winford and James Winford in whole and sole Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament. As witness my hand and seal this
