& I give and bequeath to my two daughters

Susanna Bottom the plantation on which I now live in
County of Henrico to be equally divided between them, and all
the rest of my Estate both real & personal I do give and
bequeath to my two daughters above named and the
all other Estate being equally divided between them
and their Heirs forever. In Witness whereof
I John Bottom have hereunto set my hand and
signed sealed & delivered

At a Court held for Henrico County the first day of October 1781
This Will was proved by the Oaths of Thomas Watkins & William
Tamm two of the Justices of the Peace and ordered to be Recorded. And
in the Motion of Benjamin Gathright, Administrator with the
said Will annexed was granted from on the Testator's Estate
he having made Oath thereunto, and together with Miles Gathright
and Joseph Gathright ^{Henrico Co. Wills, Estates, 1770-1787} entered into and acknowledged
their Bond in the penalty of thirty thousand pounds of legal
Tobacco functions as the law directs.
