of Richmond, and parish of St. James, being weak in body, but of sound
senses, and memory, do make and declare this my last Will & Testament
in manner following. I think it my will & desire that all my
Just and lawful debts, and funeral charges, be paid by my Executors
hereafter named. I think it my will & desire that the lot and
improvements thereon which on I now live, known in the plan of the
City, by the half of A. and the half of B. (measuring sixty feet in
front, and the breadth of the lot in depth) To be sold after my death
to my brother Samuel Leggett, and my negro man named
Harry and his child, my Colored Son, and all my household &
kitchen furniture, be sold by my Executors. I give and be-
queath to my brother Samuel Leggett the sum of twenty pounds, and
all my negroes. I give and bequeath to my sister
Agatha Leggett, Abigail Leggett, my Sister Rebecca Coston,
Elisha Leggett, the sum of ten pounds, Elizabeth Powell, Sarah Powell,
my Son, and John Sampson Powell my negroes, the sum of
twenty five pounds each, to wit money of Virginia. I think
it my will & desire that my Sister Samuel Leggett, the
sum of fifty feet of ground in front, and the breadth of the lot

State, or profits arising from the same, have in any manner
arising therefrom, being equally divided between Samuel Suggs, William
Suggs, Agatha Suggs, Barnabe Suggs, Elizabeth Suggs, John
Carlin, Andrew Carlin, Ann & Frederick, Elizabeth Powell, William
Powell, Henry Powell, John Sampson Powell, Sarah Powell, John Cooke
son of my Vice Sarah Cooke, to them and their heirs forever.
I have & I hereby appoint my worthy friends, Richard Crook, John
Roper, John Clark, John Eliza son of Thomas, Executors to this
my Last Will & Testament, declaring all other Wills to be Void &
Null.
