Haskins executor of this my last will & Testament

between George Traylor & George Pffoord and
to their heirs or assigns —
I am I, viz. to my loving wife now for all y^e rest of
her life to be at her disposing —
I have appointed & appointed my son in Law William
Haskins Executor of this my last will & testament
after my just funeral expences & other legacies
first paid & discharged for Confirmation & in
testimony of the same have signed with my
hand & seals this 27th of February: 1721 —
