Jesus Christ to receive free Pardon and Remission of all my sins and my
body to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned
first I will and desire that my Death and funeral Charges be truly and
paid and discharged, Then I Give unto my Daughter Sarah Morley one
Shilling Sterling, Then I Give unto my Daughter Mary Hatcher one
Shilling Sterling, Then I Give unto my Daughter John Hancock one
Shilling Sterling, Then I Give unto my Son Robert Hancock
one Shilling Sterling, Then I Give unto my Daughter Phebe Baly
my Riding Horse and Saddle and my Blacksmith's Tools, Then
I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Hancock my Negro Girl
Watts with her increase to her and her Heirs for ever during her
Life and after her death her increase to be equally divided among the
Children The Shall then have that are Lawfully begotten of her
body and all the rest of my whole Estate I Give and bequeath unto my said Daughter Elizabeth
Hancock my full sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament making void all other Wills
and Testaments by me heretofore made Witness my Hand and Seal this 22. Day of Sept. 1796
