is in this case that if I die & the plantation should
be sold to my Son Robert & his heirs

land & give one from the three acres of land & one
and a half called fancy with the house & the land

Item I give & bequeath to my Son Joseph Stewart
& his heirs for ever one negro male called Joe
one female called Bess & a blanket 14 lbs of
& clothes two coats & give one from the three acres
& the land

Item I give & bequeath to my Son Joseph Stewart
one negro male called Jack with the house & the land

Item I Give & Bequeath to my Son John & his heirs for Ever
one Negro Girl called Bob with her clothes one Rugg
with Rugg blanket 1 yd Sheet, three cows & Calves two
cows & pigs one young lamb one Iron pot three
Dishes & Cylats & breeding mare

Item I Give to my Son John one Negro Boy named Henry
with his clothes one Rugg one Rugg blanket 1 yd Sheet, three cows & Calves two
cows & pigs one young lamb one Iron pot three
Dishes & Cylats

Item I Give & Bequeath to my Son Thomas & his heirs
for Ever one Negro Boy named Jacob with his clothes
one Rugg & blanket 1 yd Sheet, one young lamb
one young goat three Dishes Cylats, 2 Hens & Cows
two cows & pigs

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Given & bequeath to my Son Robert Stewart & his
heirs for ever One Negro Boy named Isaac, also
One feather bed Ring & Blanket one in Throat thro
Canes & Calves two Saws & pigs 1 front porch 3 Baskets
of lard & young brooding mare.
