

Know all men by these presents that I Judith Randolph
Widow and next of Henry Randolph of the County of
Henrico gent. dead, do acknowledge by these presents
to be justly indebted unto my sonne Henry Randolph six
thousand four hundred seventy one pounds of tobacco
was given to my sonne asured by the Grand Assembly
not being a debt due to the father from the Estate of my
sd husband dead, and now is due to my sd sonne out
of the sd Estate as aforesd.

I doe also in consideration of the true love and affection
wch I bear to my sd sonne Henry Randolph (as well as to
the memory of his father dead) and for the advancement
and preferment of him my sd sonne, hereby binde my self
my heirs exec^{rs} and assigns in whate soever I or shall
or may be hereafter possesser of my Estate, to pay out
of my sd Estate six thousand five hundred twenty nine
pounds of good sound Marchable toba and Casq (to my
sd sonne Henry Randolph) wch wth the sume aforesaid
is in all twelve thousand pounds of tobacco and Casq, and
is to be paid as aforesd when my sd sonne shall come to the
age of twenty one years, wch will happen (if he lives) to be
upon the sixteenth day of Jan^{ry} A^d Anno 1686. for all wch

is in all twelve thousand pounds of Tobacco and Cagg and
to be paid as before when my or some come to the
age of twenty one years, wch will happen (if he lives) to be
upon the sixteenth day of Jan^{ry} A^o domini 1685. for all wch
Tobacco and Cagg I do hereby assign my estate to be justly
and to be paid according to the tenor of these presents
Provided that if my or some come before the year Eighty
we agreed that then these presents to be void as to the ad-
vantage of my or some and to stand to me and to be
wholly at my disposing and my will in that case re-
spectall of the Tobacco, not to be obstructed or contradicted
by any if I should hereafter marry to the performance of
all wch I hereunto set my hand and state the twenty first
day of September 1678 At my house in London
