I do bequeath to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of
my executors hereafter named

I do hereby bequeath my Grand Daughter Margaret the wife of Gilbert
Cook and daughter of my said son John to be my sole and true
and lawful heir and to be enjoyed by my said Grand Daughter
and her heirs forever

I do hereby bequeath my said Grand Daughter Mary the wife of John
Cook to be my sole and true and lawful heir and to be enjoyed by my said
Grand Daughter Mary and her heirs forever

I do hereby bequeath my said Grand Daughter Margaret which she now
calls herself Mary to be my sole and true and lawful heir and to be enjoyed by my said
Grand Daughter Margaret and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Joshua Wynn two Acres

I give to each of my Grand Sons, Robert Wynn, Wm. Wynn and Francis Wynn
a Gro to be delivered them when they come to lawful age.

I give and bequeath to my Son John William the Son of William Randolph one
Hundred and twenty Acres, being the lot of one Hundred and twenty Acres, which

is to be held by my Son John Wynn and his heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath all my wearing Coats to be divided among my Grand Daughters
and to my Executors

I give and bequeath to my Son Peter Jones and his heirs for ever all the rest
of my estate both real and personal and do hereby appoint my said Son,

together with William Randolph to be Executors of this my Last Will and
