one Gun. Call'd the Specteled Stock Gun. to be paid at the
Age of twenty one years. Hen I give and bequeath to my
son John Roberts one Horse. Colt and one mare one Cow
and Calf or one Cow with Calf two Sows and piggs
and one Gun to be paid him at ^(the age of) twenty one years.
Hen I give and bequeath to my son Joshua Roberts one
mare Colt and mare one Cow and Calf or one Cow with
Calf two Sows and piggs and the Draxell's Gun to be
paid him at the Age of twenty one years. Hen I give and

I then I give and bequeath to my son Joshua Roberts one
Horse Colt and mare one Cow and calf one Cow with
calf two Sows and piggs and the Bravelle's Gun to be
possessed at the Age of twenty one years. I then I give and
bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Roberts a feather Bed
and furniture the aforesaid Bed is called my Bed,
I also give her a breeding mare. I then I give and bequeath
to my Wife Elizabeth Roberts all the rest of my residue
of my Estate appointing her my whole and Sole Executrix
this my last Will & Testament as Witness my hand
and the day of February 1724/67.
