In the name of God amen I Samuel Grantley late of
 Wills & Benefactors in that part of the Kingdom of Great Britain called
 Scotland, being at this time well sick and weak in body and
 now lying ill at the House of Mr. Gabriel Galt of the City of
 Richmond in the Commonwealth of Virginia, desiring some
 and disposing mind and memory do make and declare this
 my Last Will and Testament in manner following to wit,
 In premises I give and bequeath all my estate real and
 personal of whatsoever nature or wheresoever being to my
 only son Samuel Grantley of Scotland, in the Kingdom of
