Item I have given unto my son Richard eight pence and ten shillings
of goods in token of my love

Lastly I make my loving friend William Broadbent my full
and whole Executor of this my last will testament and do
beare by publick and declare this to be my last will and testame
nt in witness whereof I have beare unto full my
hand and seale this twentieth day of September 1694
