I do rest and reserve my personal estate
good and chattels what so ever I do give and
bequeath to my son Matthew Turpin to make
him full and absolute owner of this my last
will and testament Making void all former
all former wills and testaments by me
heretofore made, in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this
day of the month of January 1717
