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Secondly, it is my Will and desire that all my Just debts
General expenses be paid by my Executor hereafter
named. Then I give and bequeath unto my brother Charles
Lewis the forty pounds I lent him which he is now
paying me. I give it to him this becom forever. Then I
give and bequeath unto my Brother Charles Lewis's Children
that is living at my death four Negroes (Viz.) Stubby then
three Children. ~~Abraham~~ ~~Joseph~~ and their increase
to be equally divided betwixt them. ~~James~~ ~~David~~ Lewis
son of my Brother Charles Lewis the said
four Negroes to be kept by my Brother
Charles Lewis for the use of the said
the said four Negroes and their
Children.

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bequeath unto my Brother Francis Lewis four hundred
pounds Military Certificate to him this heirs forever
I have I give and bequeath unto my Father Joseph
Lewis all the remainder of my Certificate of every kind
to him this heirs forever. I have I give and bequeath unto
my two Sisters Rebecca Lewis and Susannah Lewis all
the remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between
them when either of them arrives at a full age or is -

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Married I give it to them and their heirs forever. I have I
will and desire that my Estate may not be appraised
I have I do appoint my loving Father Joseph Lewis my
Brother Francis Lewis my whole and Sole Executors of
this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 16th day of
December 1784.

3rd day of January 1785. This Will was proved by the Oath of
Charles Lewis & Francis Lewis Witnesses thereto & ordered
to be Recorded. And on the motion of Joseph Lewis one of
the Executors therein named who made Oath thereto together
with William Lewis his Surety entered into Acknowledgment
that he was in the possession of two thousand pounds
Conditioned as the direct Certificate was granted
but thereof in due form.

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
