County of Sussex, being sick in body but of a sound and perfect memory
make to be always by God for it, and consent to be taken by all as such, my
Constitute and ordain this to be my last Will & Testament, in manner and
form following. 1st Item I give and bequeath to my son ~~John~~ ^{James} Threlkeld the
the plantation Westall James Britton, with fifty acres of land, once a
year to him and his heirs forever. 2^d Item I give and bequeath to my
dear and loving wife ~~Ann~~ ^{Ann} Threlkeld the plantation which I shall, with
fifty acres of land, once a year during her life, and after her decease, the
same to my son William Threlkeld, to him and his heirs forever. 3^d Item I
give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Threlkeld, one baronell of Calpe, and
one bed and furniture, by the name of Lucia, to her and her heirs forever.
4th Item my desire is that the house by the name of Deke, and the
garden by the name of Deacon, to be left for the use of both the plantations
during the life of ~~Ann~~ ^{Ann} Threlkeld, and then returned to the estate.
5th Item I give to my loving wife, all the rest of my estate real and
personal during her life, to be equally divided among my three
children. 6th Item I appoint my three sons ~~John~~ ^{James} Threlkeld, ~~William~~ ^{William} Threlkeld, and
Lucy Threlkeld, to execute this my last Will & Testament.
