My Will and desire further is that my part of the
I hold as one of the heirs of Stephen Woodson to be sold by my
Executors and my Negro Woman Macey and also such part of my stock
as my Executors shall think can be most conveniently spared if occasion
shall require it to pay my Debts. My Will and desire is that if either
my Children should die before they come of age that part of my
Estate shall be equally divided among the rest of my Children and
Wife, and if either the Negroes given to my sons should die before
my son come of age that the value of the said
Negroes out of my Estate. My Will and desire is that the three Negroes
given to my three sons are to be bound out to some trade till my son
the age of eighteen years of age. My Will and desire
that all the rest of my Estate to be kept together in possession
for the purpose of raising and educating my Children till
they are of age to benefit by it then to be equally divided
among my Children and Wife. I do appoint my

At a Court held for Henrico County of the fourth day of October the 2^d day of April 1787
This Will was proved by the Oath of Habson Owen, Joseph Morby & Robert Monif
Witnesses hereto his Executors to be proved. And on the motion of Abisha Howard
one of the Executors therein named who made Oath hereto together with
Habson Owen & John Woods his Co-executors entered into and acknowledged their
Bonds in the sum of ten thousand pounds Current as the Law directs
Certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form Liberty
being reserved to the other Executors named in the said Will to give in the probat
when they shall think fit.
