

In the Name of God Amen I now an man by these presents that I
Thomas Jones of the County of Henrico Planter being at present sick in body
but sound in Judgment & Memory do make this my last Will & Testament
in the first place I Recommend my Soul to God who gave it hoping to be
saved only by the Merits of his Dear Son Christ Jesus And for my worldly
goods my Will & Pleasure is that they be disposed of in the way and manner
following - I give and bequeath to my Son Thomas Jones and his
heirs for ever all that Tract of Land belonging to me in Bermuda Hundred
commonly called the granary together with six head of Cattle viz
four Young Cows about three or four Year Old & Two Steers of the same
Age the said Land & Cattle of that Age to be delivered to him at the Age
of fifteen Years & every part of the said Land to my Wife Martha
for her use & comfort during her life And my Will is that my said son shall
have the said Land at the said Age of fifteen Years
I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Jones at the Age
of fifteen Years the sum of £100 Marriage Two Young Cows with Cattle
& Cattle
I also give & bequeath to my said Wife Martha Jones all the
rest of my goods & Cattle not herein named in this my Will
to be sold & the proceeds thereof to be paid to her for her life And I Recommend
my Soul to God

and her heirs during her life. And my Will is that my said son shall
have the Liberty at the said age of 21 years.

Item, I give & bequeath to my Daughter Christina Jones at the age
of 21 years on the day of her Marriage Two young Cows with calves
on their sides.

Item, I do bequeath to my loving Wife Martha Jones all the
rest of my goods & Chatties not formerly named in this my Will
together with her thirds in my Land during her life. And I Nominate
~~appoint~~ the said Martha Jones my Executor & Administrator
hereby revoking all Wills & Testaments by me formerly
made. In Witnesst thereof I have sett my hand & Seal to these
presentes Written in the County of Henrico in Virginia this 22-
day of January in the Year of our Lord 1688.
