bequeath to my Son William Fairbairn three Negroes viz
James, Dudley & Frank to him & his heirs forever. Item I give
and bequeath to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Fairbairn one
Negro Girl named Ruth, to her & her heirs forever. Item
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Galbraith
three Negroes viz viz Joe, Dick & Charles, and one feather
Bed to her & her heirs forever. Item I give & bequeath to my
second Daughter Rebecca Galbraith one Negro Girl
named Rachel to her & her heirs forever. Item I give and
bequeath to my Daughter Anne Bonford three Negroes Hannah,
Lind & Lion, also one feather Bed to her & her heirs forever.

James of Elton, also one feather Bed to her then heirs forever
Now I give Bequeath to my Grand daughter Mary Ann
Bought one Negroe boy named Ned to her then heirs
forever Now I give Bequeath to my Grand daughter
Ann I give two Negroes viz: one Negroe boy named
Giles and one Negroe girl named Sally to her then heirs
forever Now I give and Bequeath to my Grand son
Silketh I give two Negroes One Negroe boy named Jack
and one Negroe girl named Betty to him then heirs forever
Now I give my son William I give my great love one round
Table and all my wearing clothes one feather bed one horse
one cart and wheels, all my harness and all my working
tools to him and his heirs forever Now I give these
children William I give him all my land and all my
and sheep, Bay Halls and all my tools and all my
household goods I give to him and his heirs forever
Now I give and Bequeath to my Grand daughter Mary Ann
all my land and all my tools and all my household goods
to her and her heirs forever

 December 1784 This Will was proved by the Oaths of John
 Crofford & Thomas Childers Witnesses thereto & Ordered to be Recorded
 And on the motion of Wm. Tapp one of the Executors named
 who made Oath thereto together with William Galloway & John
 his Executors entered into & acknowledged their Bond in the penal sum of
 ten thousand five hundred pounds Conditionally as the said decessor's Legacies
 were granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form of Law
 being returned to the other Executors named in the said Will before the
 probat when it shall think fit.
