be equally divided between Aaron my son & Nathaniel my
son. I give unto my Daughter Martha Ann a Negro
woman by name Desha her Child by name Edmund
and her Increase. I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth a
negro woman by name Nann and her Increase.
I give unto my Daughter Mary Ann a Negro woman by
name Jude and her Child by name Jan & their increase
Also the remainder part of the Negroes to be equally
Divided between all my Children if the they cannot be
equally Divided then to be sold and divided each Child to have
its equal part But also the whole of my Estate to be continuing
