I bequeath my Body to the Earth from whence I was
taken and also my Soul into the Hands of my
faithful Creator who hath made all Mankind to
be Honored & glory both now and for ever. In witness
I do by these Presents make my beloved Wife Anne
my full & whole Executrix of all my Goods & Chattels
God hath given unto me in Virginia or elsewhere
particular I give unto my Wife a pair of four Moleh (one
a Steer and an Heifer that is on Lawns Creek with
and a young Yearling Bull. Also I give unto my
Daughter Frances a Yearling Heifer, and if this Heifer
should die in the mean time my Wife shall make
it good out of her own Stock. Also I give unto my
son John Wilmoth a Cow Calf and to my son Robert
Wilmoth a Cow Calf and if these Cow Calves should
die my Wife Annis Wilmoth shall make them

20 good out of her own Stock. Also if any of these
Children dye before they come to Age it is my Will
the said Cattle shall come to the Survivors. Also
the Plantations that we are Upon I give unto my
Wife and all my Household Stuff & Moveables
I give I intrust John Jackson & George Coker
to be my Overseers for performance of my last
Will & Testament being a true Act & Deed of
my own Will Witness my Hand this 15th Day
of February 1647

the said Cap^t John Upton and in Breadth thence from
the Point road for a Landing place belonging unto
