Conveyance unto M^r William Ruffin and his Heirs
or Assigns for ever.

I John Oliver being in good Health of Body
bound for England do order & dispose of that
the which it hath pleased God of his Mercy
bestow upon me in case it should please God
to take me to himself before I shall return hither
Virginia again as followeth. Imprimis
I bequeath my Soul to God my Merciful Saviour
& Redeemer & my Body to be Buried and my

Debt being first paid. Item. I Give
 Wife Ellen Oliver my full & whole Estate
 and every part of my Estate these Legacies being
 being first paid. For my Land on which I have
 and Three hundred Acres of Land, which I have
 Blockwater I do Give & Bequeath unto my two
 Daughters equally between them. Item. I Give
 and Bequeath unto my eldest Daughter Three
 out of my Stock of Cattle and their Increase
 Item. I Give & Bequeath unto my Youngest
 Daughter Three Yearling Heifers and their Increase
 and if any of these Cattle so given to my two Daughters
 shall dye within the Year then my Will is that
 young Cattle shall be put in y^e place & stead thereof
 but of y^e remainder of my Cattle: Item. I Give
 and Bequeath unto my two Daughters half a dozen of
 pewter Dishes to each of them Item I Give &
 Bequeath my son John a Cow-Calf which is fallen this Year
 Item for all the rest of my Estate I do leave it
 wholly to my loving Wife whom before I have made
 my whole Exceutrix to be at her disposing And
 for the performance of this my last Will and
 Testament I do Appoint my loving Friends James
 Pyland and Robert Bird Overseers. In
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 Hand & Seal this 19th of April. 1652
