

In the Name of God. Amen. I

John Miles being sick and weak in Body but of perfect Memory for which I bless and praise the Almighty God, and my dearer Saviour Jesus Christ, I do make this my Last Will and Testament (as followeth). —

I give and bequeath my Body to the Earth to be decently Interred therein, and I bequeath my Soul into the hands of Jesus Christ my most Loving and Merciful Saviour and Redeemer Humbly Beseeching him of his Infinite mercy to pardon and to forgive me all my sins, and to present me without Spot and blame before the presence of his Father, to whom with the holy Ghost I do ascribe from the ground and Bottom of my Heart, all Honour and Glory both now and for Evermore, Amen.

And for that Debts the which I both praise God of his Mercy to bestow upon me, my Debts being first paid I give and bequeath as followeth. —

I give and bequeath unto my Son John Miles all my Plantation being Two Hundred Acres of Land together with the Cattle hereafter specified, (Viz. 6) Sows called by the name of Pile, and one Brander sow called by the name of Portland and a red sow with a bob tail, a paleered sow called by the name of Wye, and one Whitish brown pyed Heifer about three years old and one blackish cow-calf white about the udder and about the hinder feet, and one cow-calf of a red colour which was pale when I was young, All which Cattle being seven in number I do give unto my son John Miles with all their increase both male & female, as also I give unto my Son John Miles one Grifted Sow Shoote about half a year old.

I give unto John Murry my Godson one Cow-calf to be paid the next ensuing year.

I give unto Elizabeth Johnson my Goddaughter one Cow-calf to be paid Two years hence.

I give unto Isaac Maddin my Goddaughter one Cow-calf to be paid Three years hence.

Item I give and bequeath all the remainder of my
 Estate, whether Land, Tithings, Household stuff, Household
 Debts, or any other thing to and belonging to my wife
 Appertaining unto my Loving Wife Elizabeth Stiles
 and do make here my full & whole Express of this
 my Last Will & Testament.

Item I do desire my Loving Friend Humphrey
 Clarke to be my Overseer to see this my Last
 Will & Testament performed & fulfilled. And in
 Witness of the Truth hereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & Seal this 26th of Octob. 1632.

In the Name of God, Amen. I Cap:
 John E. Stiles of the Shire of Wight County in Virginia
 of full Age, being sick of Body but in perfect Memory do
 declare this to be my Last Will and Testament in Manner
 and Form as Followeth, (that is to say) First I commit my
 Soul to the Earth from whence it came to be decently
 interred at the discretion of my Executors hereafter men-
 tioned. And my Soul to God hoping for
 Salvation through the Merits of my Lord & Saviour
 Jesus Christ, and for such worldly goods as God in his
 Mercy hath bestowed upon me I bequeath and Give in
 Manner & Form Following, Imprimis, Item.
 I give Devise & bequeath unto my eldest son John
 Vpton all that Tract of Land being part of it in the
 Tenure of John King, James Bagwell, & Nicholas
 Morris, containing in the Whole Eight Hundred and
 fifty Acres of Land, and if the said John Vpton
 dies before he comes to the Age of one and twenty
 years then at give and bequeath the said Land unto
