I Richard Death of the State of Wight County
Virginia being very sick & weak of Body but
perfect Mind & Memory praised be God do hereby
make & ordain this my last Will & Testament
in manner and form following. First I commend
my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God
hoping & assuredly believing through the Merits &
Grace of Jesus Christ my Saviour to receive
pardon & remission of all my sins, and my Body
to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of my
Executors hereafter named: but as concerning all
such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to endow me (my Debts which of Wight
or elsewhere I owe unto any Man being first paid &
satisfied) I give & bequeath (viz) Imprimis
I give and bequeath unto the Child my daughter
Elizabeth Dodman Wife of John Dodman now
yeoman withall one Cow calf already calved by the
Cow called Wastes old Cow, but if it shall happen

the said Child dye before it comes to Age then he shall have
 Calf with her Increase I Give unto John Dodman son of
 the said John Dodman Item I Give to Bequeath unto
 the said John Dodman jun^r & Richard Dodman son
 of the said John Dodman Sen^r one Mayesty or half of
 such Goods Chattels Lands Movables & Immovables as
 shall be the Estate of me the said Richard Death my
 Laws being first satisfied as afo^r. But if it shall
 happen the said John or Richard should dye or
 depart this Life before they attain the Age of One and
 Twenty Years that then he that shall be surviving to—
 possess the Estate of the other so deceased And if it
 shall happen that both the said John & Richard
 shall dye or depart this Life before the said Age of One and Twenty Years
 then the Estate bequeathed to belong & come unto
 the said John Dodman Item I Give to Bequeath unto William Death my Son Eldest
 Son of Robert Death of London the other Mayesty
 or half of such Goods as shall be the Estate of
 me the said Richard Death as afo^r as Goods Chattels
 Lands Movables & Immovables but if it shall happen
 the said William Death shall be departed this Mortal
 Life that then the Estate bequeathed unto him I Give
 and Bequeath unto John & Richard Dodman as afo^r
 Sons of the said John Dodman Item I Give and
 Bequeath unto Christopher Neal son of Daniel Neal
 of the Isle of Wight County afo^r one Cow Calf & any
 of the Cattle of me the said Richard Death which shall
 be next Calved Item I will that the Estate bequeathed
 as aforesaid unto John & Richard Dodman Sons of the
 said John Dodman remain in the Hands & Custody of
 the said John Dodman Sen^r untill they shall attain
 unto the Age of One and Twenty Years. And if the

my last Will & Testament to make & ordain to wit
 John Dodman son my sole & full Executor and to
 execute all former Wills & Testaments In Witness
 whereof I the said Richard Death unto this my last
 Will and Testament have set my Hand & Seal this
 Third day of March 1647

I Edward Wilmoth being at this time very weak
 Body but perfect of Memory praised be God for
 I bequeath my Body to the Earth from whence I was
 taken and also my Soul into the Hands of my
 faithful Creator who hath made all Mankind to
 be Honored & glory both now and for ever. In witness
 I do by these Presents make my beloved Wife Ann
 my full & whole Executrix of all my Goods & Chattels
 God hath given unto me in Virginia or elsewhere
 particularly I give unto my Wife a pair of four Molech (two
 or three) and an Heifer that is on Lawns Creek with
 and a young Yearling Bull. Also I give unto my
 Daughter Frances a Yearling Heifer, and if this Heifer
 should dye in the mean time my Wife shall make
 it good out of her own Stock. Also I give unto my
 son John Wilmoth a Cow Calf and to my son Robert
 Wilmoth a Cow Calf and if these Cow Calves should
 miscarry my Wife Annis Wilmoth shall make them
