

In fth name of God Amen: In Twentieth day of Sept^r in fth year of o^r S^h Edward the Third one Thousand four hundred & eighty, I Wille^m Tyner in fth Isle of Wyght County in Wyght being very sick & weak in Body but of sound mind & memory, thanks be given unto God hereunto, Calling to mind fth mortality of my Body and knowing y^t it is appointed for all men once to dye, do make this my last will & Testament (that is to say) principally first of all, I give & recommend my Soul, unto y^e hands of God that graciously and for my Body, I commend it to y^e earth to be buried in a private & devout manner, at y^e discretion of my Ex^{or} without doubting but y^e General Assurances, I shall receive y^e same againe by y^e mighty power of God And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this life I give and devise & dispose of the same in y^e following manner & forme

I give unto my Sonne Wille^m Tyner & heire after my plantacion wherof I now devise Containing One Hundred & thirty Acres of Land more or lesse, to all his heirs & Orheards, & all other appoyntments therunto belonging, after my decease, I also give unto my loving Sonne Nicholas off^r of a Tract of Land in Rural Northamptonshire, containing three hundred Acres, & also three hundred & forty Acres on both sides, where Rob^t Thomas doth live, & also forty Acres of Lakes on both sides, & also three hundred & one two year Old Mare running in y^e woods, & five Hares & Colts more, & all my stock of Hogs, & all my debts y^e is due to me after my decease either by Bills or Cunts, y^e Justly is due to me to him & his Heires

I give to my daughter Margaret, two Cowes & Calves, & y^e plantacion wherof she now lives in Rural Northamptonshire, being y^e remainder off^r of y^e Land before given to her & her Heires

I give unto my daughter Mary five Cowes & Calves, & also two hundred Acres of Land on Curlewary Swamp being y^e plantacion y^e formerly was Thosth Mannes, to and from both y^e houses & both Parks one on each side & Boulston & pair of Shoote & Blawdons

I give unto my daughter Margaret parsonage One Iron pott to Hocks & pott Hacks & one Old Bed to one of y^e Blawdons & one Shoote

I give unto my daughter Elene five Cowes & Calves & one young Mare called Shabby, one small pott to pott Hocks & pott Hacks, to and from both sides to and from both y^e houses & pott Hacks one on each side & Shoote

I give unto my daughter Sarah one Cow & Calves, if she will have it and use more

I give unto my Sonne Nicholas my Oxen Riding Horse called Slaver

I give unto my daughter Mary one young Mare called Bomby

I give unto my Sonne in Law David parsonage one Old furred Mare

I give unto my two daughters Elene & Mary one Mare called Paney & her mare, and my Sonne Nicholas to divide y^e mare betwixt them

I give unto my Sonne Nicholas Town sides of Tamed Soakles, I also give unto my Sonne Nicholas three Iron wedges & all my Carpenter's Tools

I give unto my three daughters Margaret Mary & Elene all my house hold stuff y^e is not already given excepting one great Basin & one small Basin, & rack of y^e one stock of Bees, & two stock of Bees unto my Sonne Wille^m Tyner, and all y^e rest of my estate I give & devise it may be divided equally divided among y^e rest of my Children excepting my daughter Sarah, & my part of the stock shall have not more than it is already given her

I give unto my daughter Elene one hundred & fifty Acres of Land in Rural Northamptonshire Congel & Hamlet more or lesse I say to her & her Heires

Imp². I do hereby constitute authorize & appoint my loving son Richard Duke of Devon-
 shire County my whole & sole Ex^{or} of this my last will & Testament, to fulfill the my last will
 & Testament, & I do hereby wholly disallow, revoke & rescind all every other former Will
 & Legacies made in any wayes before this my hand sealed & subscribed
 Ratifying & Confirming this & new offer to my last will & Testament, In witness whereof
 I have hereunto sett my hand & fixed my Seale this day & year beforeme written

In y^e Name of God Amen, y^e 20th day of October 1708 I Wm West of Newport Parish in y^e County of y^e Isle of Wight being sick & weak in body, but of sound & perfect memory (praise be given to God for y^e same), shewing y^e uncertainty of this life on earth, & being desirous to settle things in order & make this my last Will & Testament in manner, & form following: That is to say, first & principally, I do commend my soul to Almighty God my Creator, & fully believing that I shall receive full pardon & free remission of all my sins, & be saved by y^e precious death, & merits of my blessed saviour, Jesus Christ Jesus, & my body to y^e earth, from whence it was taken, to be buried in earth & sent to Christian manner, as to my ~~last~~ hereafter named shall be thought most convenient. And as for what worldly estate y^e Lord in Mercy hath lent me, my Will & meaning is, y^e same shall be employed, as hereafter by this my Will & meaning is ~~expressed~~ shall be expressed. & first I do revoke, & revoke & frustrate, & make void, all Wills by me made, & declare, & appoint this my last Will & Testament: That I do give, sell, & my land lying between W^m

equally to his desired betwixt y^e & my son Riche to have y^e part of y^e land next to
Grosens, & after y^e decease, to y^e heirs of y^e house largely, & gotten for ever.

I Give & devise unto my son Robt West, one part of a profit of land, vizt I purchased of Cap: M^r
Wells beginning att a white Oak, in a little branch & 200 downe y^e little branch to a long branch
 & 200 downe y^e 2^d long branch, unto W^m Nashratts line, & from y^e 2^d white Oak downe
 Indian path to Cap: Apprehants line, & 200 along Cap: Apprehants line Eastward unto
W^m Nashratts former line, & 200 along Cap: Apprehants y^e 2^d line to y^e first station for
 during his Naturall life, & after his decease unto y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever.

From y^e l^{ine} & d^{iv}is^{ion} unto my sons W^m West, & Rich^d West y^e rem^{ain}der of y^e afores^d land bought
of Cap^t W^m Oldislyng on y^e South side of y^e Indian path begining att Round hill, & running up
till Northworthys l^{ine} to y^e Indian path, & 300 from Round hill along Coll^{es} Pitts l^{ine}, to Cap^t
Approbahes l^{ine}, & 300 along Cap^t Approbahes l^{ine} to y^e Indian path, for pouring y^e naturall
l^{and} equally to be d^{iv}ided betw^{en} us: & after y^e d^{ev}is^{ion} unto y^e heirs of y^e bodyes longfull brother

I give & devise unto my son Robt West y^e land whereon he now liveth wth me: I bought of M^r John
 Marshall y^e said being about one hundred eighty acres for redeeming his naturall life, & after
 his decease unto y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever.
