to all men once to Dy and knowing how soon my time may be that I must
Depart out of this Tabernacle and house of Clay Do therefore make this my
Last will and Testament this twenty Eighth Day of the twelfth month (called
February) in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifteen
Sixteen where in I make all others of my wills void null and of no Effect &
first I Give up my Soul to Christ Jesus my Saviour and my body to the Earth to be
Buried with Christian burial and all my worldly Goods & Estate that the
Lord hath Given me here in this World I Give and bequeath in manner &
form as is here Expressed following and first I give unto my Dear & Loving
Wife Sarah the Solo Use & p^{oss}ession of the plantation I now Live on until my son
Benjamin arrives to the age of twenty one years and after wards she having
her thirds During her natural Life and after wards to him and his heirs
for ever -

I Give unto my three Children Margret Sarah & Benjamin each of the ma
jor portion of the furniture when they come to age or Marriage I Give unto my
son Benjamin a Silver Chalice Cup & porringer of his mothers Deceased and
my Gurney and Chair when he hath Discretion to use them I give unto my wife
Sarah & our three Children viz (Margret Sarah & Benjamin nine
Silver Spoons & a Sack (up to be equally Divided between them by weight at
the Day she alter the her condition by marriage I give unto my Daughter
Margret a Strong water Still at her mothers Deceased I give unto my
Daughter Sarah my Negro boy (called Peter at her mothers Deceased
but off he Dy before that time then the two Girls to have an equal
part of off above) Still I give unto my son Benjamin a peck of salt
Peck now standing in the house and so long as my Wife Sarah remain
a Widow I Give her of the Use of the Residue of my Whole p^{oss}ession & Estate but at
the Day of her Marriage again I that their be an Equal Division between
her & our three Children & if it be by Lot & I Do Desire that my three Bre
thren viz (James Robert & Richard to be over Seers & if nothing be
Done or acted to the out of Consent or approbation I Do constitute & ordain
my Dear & Loving Wife Sarah to be Ex^{ec} of this my Last will and Testament
and to fulfill it in Witnes^{ss} here of I have hereunto set my hand and
fixed my Seal of Day & year above Written & I have an account of
thirty one pounds of money due to me from Robert five fifteen I give to my wife and the
will I give to my three Children to be equally Divided amongst them viz (Benjamin
