begotten a Negro Girl called Rose and in Case my said daughter die without
issue then to survivor or survivor of such my Children as aforesaid
- I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha and her heirs of her body
one Negro called Maria and in Case she die without issue then to the survivor
or survivor of such my Children as aforesaid
- I give and bequeath unto my daughter Parience and the heirs of her body
lawfully begotten a feather bed and furniture and in Case she die without
issue then the said bed and furniture to go to and for my daughter Florence
and in Case she die without issue then to come to the survivor or survivor of such
my Children as aforesaid
- I give and bequeath unto my daughter Florence one feather bed and
furniture and to the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever and
in Case she die without issue then to come to the survivor or survivor of my
Children aforesaid
- I give to my Loving Wife Martha Bode one feather bed and
furniture

Good to my Son Benjamin one feather Bed and furniture and in Case
he die would give that to the Survivor or Survivors of my Children a fourth
good and bequest to my son Perry; my Pistol, Penknife and Sword
My Will and Desire that all the other moveables then in my house be equally divided
between my Wife and Children

I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Martha the plantation known Dwell
or during the Natural life and after her decease to my son Roy^l and his
Heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten —

I Give to my Son Benjamin all the Remaining part of my Land and to the
Heirs of this Body Lawfully begotten for Ever and in Case my said son die
without Issue as aforesaid then the said Land shall be divided between the survive
or Survivors of my Children and their Heirs.

Enjoying all such Legacy I have or shall leave him Immediately after my
Decease.

My Will and desire is that all such stock of Cattle Horses and Hares and
Sheep n^d are to be found belonging to me to be Equally divided between my
Wife and Children —

My Will and Desire is that my aforesaid Daughters have their Legacies paid them when they come to the age of sixteen or Married.

my Son Benjamin Beel to be Ex^r and Ad^r of the my last Will and

 of pewter and three plates half New half Old and one Cow of six Years Old one
 heifer of two Years Old

Give to my Daughter Elizabeth one Iron pot and Hooks and ten pounds of pewee
and three plates and one Egg and one Kisser
