And for my worldly Goods after my Just Debt is paid I
give & bequeath as followeth —
Item I give unto my Son John Chapman my Bed and
furniture whereon I now lie —
Item I give unto my Son John Chapman his mother's
Dressing box Comb Case & Looking glass & all therein con-
tained —
I give unto my Son John Chapman my best Coat & five
Damask Napkins —
I give unto my Son John Chapman my great Copper
Plate pan —
I give unto my Son John Chapman half my powder —
I give unto my Son John Chapman my best Coat waist-
coat & Brackets —
I give unto my Son John Chapman my Silver Shoe buckles
& my great Bible together with half of my Divinity &
History books —
Item I give unto my Grandson Charles Chapman my two best
Pilgrims —
Item I give unto my Grandson Charles Chapman my two best
& new best Silver together with all the singular my other Es-
tates Real & personal unto my Son Joseph & his heirs
& I do hereby constitute & appoint my Son Joseph
Chapman my Sole & sole Exr. of this my last will &
Testament revoking all other wills whatsoever Dated
