more over my personal Estate all my Just Debt being first paid
I give to my Loving wife Rebecca and my Daughter in Law Sarah
Marshall to be Equally Divided and I Do appoint John Watts an
Amor Jordan and John Butler and John Senger either two of
me to Divide & Estate between you and to make under my
Loving Wife to be my whole and Sole Ex^{rs} -

The Last will and Testament of Edward Long was
produced in Court by Mary his widow and Edrd who made oath there to
being proved in Court by oath of 7 Witnesses & admitted to record

In the name of God amen I John White of the County of W^{est} being
now sick and weak in body but through Gods blessing in good sense and
memory do justify and ordain this my last will and Testament in
manner and form as followeth

I give my soul to almighty God my creator and Redeemer in my body
to be decently buried in Earth and when my Soul shall depart
and my funeral Charges Completed with all I give & Recommend of my
Estate as followeth

Give to my Son Josiah White one Large Silver Spoon

Give to my Daughter Sarah White of 200 with 20⁰ (sterling) in the
Green worsted Rugg with other furniture such as is valuable
and one Silver Sack (Cup)

Give to my Daughter Mary White a Sma^{ll} flat hat band
of Silver made Jst M

Give to my Son Wm White one Silver Spoon

Give to my Daughter Rachell White one Silver Spoon

Give to my Son Thomas White my Riding mare brindle & saddle

Give to my Son John White a pattern of Druggott and Linning buttons
and silk for a suit of Cloths

Give to my Daughter Elizth Scott one powder horn in the form of a
horn to it

Give to my young Daughter Elizth White my Great Looking Glass

Give all of Rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided between and
amongst my Above named Children and I do that my Son
hereafter named do take care in bringing up of my small
Children and giving them schooling and I do nominate my
Son in Law Wm Scott my whole and Sole Ex^{or} and my Son Tho^s
White likewise my Ex^{or} with him in Witness Whereof I have
set my hand and Seal this 1st Day of March 1718
