by Entered with J^d John Allen with Right already in his hands
viz (beginning at a great Spring Branch running down over the
old mahoning path for the Complement aforesaid as also I give
to the J^d Perry five hundred pounds of Tobacco -

I Give & bequeath to my Loving Cousin John Gullam Son of Capt.
Hinchee Gullam all of Rest of my Land Good & Chattels in nature
and Quality Whatsoever & I Do here by Revoke all other wills
by me here to fore made making this my Cousin John Gullam
my Whole and Sole Executor of this my Last will and Testament
Whereof I have here to Set my hand and Affixed my Seal the
Day and year first above Written
