I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Lillbourne a young steer -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anne Bridgwood a cow -

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Lupp a cow and the feather Bed in Room fronting the Side Gate in -

I give and bequeath to my Eldest Daughter Bridgwood a young Heifer -

I give and bequeath to my Son John Lupp my Gun and Sword and my Young Hairs and a young Heifer when he comes to the age of sixteen years -

I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Sarah all the Residue and Remainder of my Estate during her Natural life and after her death I give and bequeath unto my Son John Lupp and do make her my said Love Wife whole and Sole Ex^{rs} of this my Last Will and Testament in testimony of which I have hereunto put my hand and seal this 24th of Aug^r 1712
