Fourthly - I give to my granddaughter - Martha Sanders one hundred acres of land more or less lying on West side of the Beaver Dam swamp bounded as the former deed is with that was to her father and mother to her and her heirs for ever.

Fifthly - I do give unto Thomas Jones that Land he now lives on and which he bought of my Brother John Jones to him and his heirs for ever.

I do give to my son Thomas Roberts all my land on the Lower side of the Reddy-
Branch to the Long Branch to him and his heirs for Ever
I do give all the Remainder part of my land
