

In the name of God Amen the 20th of the month of April 1707 I John Perks being in perfect mind & memory do make this my last will & testament in manner & form as followeth first I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty God my Creator in hope of a joyful Resurrection thro' the merits of my only Saviour Jesus Christ in whom I hope for Salvation my Body I will to my wife to be buried at my discretion at my house as shall be hereafter named I doo dispose of my worldly estate as followeth

I give & bequeath to my sonne John Perks One Shilling besides a portion I gave him formerly

I give & bequeath to my sonne Thomas Perks One Shilling besides a portion I formerly gave him

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Susannah One Shilling besides a portion I formerly gave her

I give & bequeath unto my sonne George Perks One little Iron potte & two Buckets & two Hangings One Boll-motte & one more of Buckets One Iron Spitt & one more two deep dishes One Basin One Iron potte One set of Iron hodgeys One small Taffoy One Hoop & one Bedd & furnishing & three Cows & Calves

I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Jane all that part of my personal estate besides what I have already given I doo also give unto my said wife all my land during her naturall life And after her decease I doo give & bequeath all my interest in land to my sonne George Perks to him & his heirs for ever

I doe Ordain appoint my loving wife Jane Perks to be my whole sole executrix of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & fixed my seal the day & year first above written

Reserving all other debts & Testaments either by word or writing

I give to my Sonne Juliana Hosworth halfe my Inheritance of Land lying in the Parish of Saint James & I offer halfe to my Brother Peter Blak to have & his Heirs lawfully begotten of his Body for ever & for want of either such heires to fall to my Sonne Thomas Hosworth Sonne of my Brother George Hosworth decess'd to him & his Heirs lawfully begotten of his Body for ever & for want of such heires to my Sister Marthe Hosworth daughter as executrix of my Brother

I give to my Sonne Peter Blak my Bed & Boulters

I give unto my Sister Marthe Hosworth daughter of my Brother George Hosworth decess'd One hoges his named Jane for the Heires of her Body lawfully begotten for ever

I give to my Sister Marthe Hosworth halfe my Cattle & halfe my Sheep the other halfe to be divided between my Brother George Hosworth & his Heirs, only one small Horse I give to my Sonne George Hosworth Sonne of my Brother

I give to my Sister Marthe Hosworth Six Silver spoons & Six to my Sister Marthe Hosworth daughter of my Brother One Silver Tankard to my Sonne Juliana Hosworth & One Tankard to my Sonne Peter Hosworth and the rest of my goods I doe

I give to my Sonne John Hosworth & Juliana Hosworth daughter of George Hosworth decess'd

I give to my Sonne George Hosworth that is now in England my Horse & furnitures
